

## Recognizing that that the P5+1 Agreement with Iran (the “Agreement”) is an accomplished fact, we, the undersigned, urge the Israeli government to adopt certain policies in light thereof, as follows:

1. Renew the trust between and enhance the political and security cooperation with the US administration in order to prepare for the challenges emanating from the Agreement, including:
  - formation of procedures for monitoring the implementation of the Agreement and required measures to be taken in case of its breach;
  - intelligence cooperation for monitoring the fulfilment of the Agreement by Iran and an early detection of any breach;
  - preparation for relevant action - political, economic, and military - to be taken in the event of a breach of the agreement by Iran;
  - intelligence coordination in order to detect Iran’s subversive actions in the region, and preparation for counter-actions to restrain and negate them;
  - furnishing special military assistance to Israel in order to guarantee its qualitative advantage, without ignoring quantitative aspects of the conventional arms race that is expected following the Agreement;
2. Initiate a political move which will provide credibility to Israel’s support of a two-state solution and that will enable, among its many advantages, the establishment of a moderate Sunni-Western axis which will act against the extremist forces that foster instability in the region.

Such policies will enable both the integration of Israel’s capabilities with those regional and international players who share the view of nuclear Iran as a serious threat, and the recruiting of moderate Arab states for the advancement of a political settlement between Israel and the Palestinians.
